COURSE OBJECTIVES :

To provide an understanding of the subject knowledge involved in the striking and fielding game of Stoolball. To examine the basic principles of Stoolball and the basic rules of the game.

PRINCIPLES OF THE NATURE OF THE GAME :

The concept of limiting the oppositions ability to score runs and to maximise the ability to score runs when striking. To contrast parallel running with circuit running games.
